Provide First Aid HLTAID003 will be held in the Pearl Beach Hall on Saturday November 14 commencing at 9.00am.

- Course time is 8 hours.
- Cost is \$70 per person to be paid by attendee on the day.
- The Provide First Aid Statement of Attainment is valid for 3 years subject to the CRP component of this course being updated every 12 months.
- o Attendees
 - a) those people due to extend their 3 year certificate.
 - b) New people wishing to obtain a Provide First Aid Statement of Attainment.

It is to be noted that both courses require candidates to bring personal ID and a USI Number (* see below).

For the National Accredited Provide First Aid course there is an on-line or paper test of 40 questions requiring an 80% pass level, however the questions are repeatedly asked until correct, so it's not too difficult.

* FEDERAL GOVERNMENT - Unique Student Identifier (USI) is your individual education identifier for life. It also creates an online record of your training attainments in Australia. If you are undertaking either nationally recognised training or a higher education qualification, you need a USI in order to receive commonwealth financial assistance, as well as to obtain your qualification or statement of attainment.
