This meeting approves the adoption of the draft Code of Conduct sent out with the papers for this meeting.

Road Network Defects

Over 50 significant safety hazards (potholes) submitted to CCC in May. Expect temporary repairs by mid June

Road Major Patching

No update on funds for major patching of worst roads, Tourmaline, Crystal and Green Point

Road Drainage

There are 4 no significant unresolved issues that CCC are investigating

- Pooling at the corner of Tourmaline and Diamond
- Blocked drainage at junction of Silex and Diamond
- Blocked drainage at 72 Cornelian
- New drainage ditch at 50 Beryl (awaiting movement of parked vehicles)

Foreshore defects and upgrades

- Proposals to remedy defects/improve area around the amenity block and playground have been submitted to CCC and a meeting with Officers is awaited.
- No update on Public Toilet Strategy
- Next Ocean Pool cleaning due August 24.
- Discussions ongoing with Craig Healey CCC regarding several Ocean pool upgrades, with no committed dates, namely:
 - Additional hand railing
 - Resurfacing of floor surfaces

Beach Safety

- CCC is proposing to install 4 new yellow flotation tubes in boxes shortly (1 now completed at the Amenities area)
- CCC is reviewing signage on ERB
- Discussion ongoing with CCC regarding improved signage/mapping of location of safety equipment on beach

Ausgrid

- Ausgrid is planning to replace life expired electricity poles on Pearl Parade between Tourmaline and Amethyst on
 - Daytime 2nd July 2024 from 8:00am through to 4:00pm
 - Night-time 15th July 2024 from 8:00pm through to 4:00am
