Constitution

- The special resolution for the purposes of Division 2 of the Associations Incorporation Act 2009 (the Act), is that:

 - For the new constitution to be adopted 75% of those who vote in person at the special general meeting must approve it. Anyone on a Zoom call is considered to be at the meeting in person.




Notes in support of the revised constitution

- This revised constitution is based on the Department of Fair Trading's Model Constitution September 2022 with specific amendments to suit our association.
- There has been consultation with the membership over the last eight months.
- Four iterations of the revised constitution have been circulated. Where suggestions
 have been made by members that have not been adopted the working party has
 endeavoured to explain the reasons for non-inclusion to that individual and at general
 meetings.

Next steps

• If the proposed constitution is adopted it will be sent to the Department of Fair Trading and will be effective once it is approved.



PBSAG – Sept Update



Community Support Centre Project – Hall "Neighbour Safer Place" (NSP): The NSP is operational with sprinklers and backup power systems. A spearpoint license was finally obtained, allowing for expanded water capacity (24 hr sprinklers) with a new pump. NSP familiarization sessions will be held on October 11th and 14th to prepare residents for the upcoming bushfire season (October). Anyone that might need to shelter (ie everyone in Pearl Beach) is strongly encouraged to attend one of these 30-minute sessions as it's important for residents have knowledge of the NSP. Bushfire Alerts: The Neighbour Alert SMS system will be discontinued in favour of the government official Hazards Near Me app. Residents are encouraged to install the app, set a Watch Zone for Pearl Beach, and receive essential fire emergency information through it. To avoid confusion and overlap, PBPA and SAG will no longer send SMS alerts to residents. The network of *Street Contacts* previously used to update contact lists for Neighbour Alert will also be disbanded.

Beach Safety: SAG is coordinating with the Council for various beach safety initiatives, including cleaning the rock pool, improving signage for the Emergency Response Beacon (ERB), and installing Yellow Rescue Tubes at strategic locations. Additionally, signs will be placed at the Amenities block to indicate the location of defibrillators.

Ocean Beach Surf Life Saving Club: The club's education team will provide beach safety education during the upcoming school holidays.

Speed Limit and Shared Use Zone: Transport NSW issued a new policy on speed limits, and Council is evaluating it. There is a suggestion to install a 40KM speed limit in Pearl Beach as a first step.

Volunteers for RFS Community Fire Unit (CFU): CFU activities include fire management until the arrival of RFS, extinguishing spot fires, and flood mitigation. The CFU team is currently under-resourced for the bushfire season, and residents are encouraged to join. Contact John Allan or Paul Toohey for more information.

CCC Liaison Convenor - Peter Richardson (from WA)

ROADS

- In contact with "Boris" from CCC on heavy patching schedule (Diamond has been recently started). Other patching to occur Tourmaline, Crystal, Greenpoint, PB Parade, Beryl/Coral and lower PB Drive
- In discussion with Steve Higgins CCC re: drainage/ponding issues on Diamond. They are not easy solutions without a big spend. Ideally these need to be addressed before they do the final sealing(bitumen & chip) which is likely to be October onwards, once the weather improves.

Other items progressing with CCC

- Additional waste bins and increased collection at the Amenity Block. Additional servicing and monitoring to continue during summer & holiday season
- Mowing Maintenance Agate and Coral. CCC will schedule 3 weekly visits, Nov -April and 5 weekly intervals at other times.
- Public Amenities. Requested additional cleaning. CCC are preparing a Public Toilet strategy and will consult us in the preparation of this.
- Stylised Map on the Amenities Block. CCC are supportive subject to approval of content and manufacturing/installation
