

Pearl Beach & Irvine Piano Scholarship recipient achieves high honour

The Central Coast Conservatorium of Music is pleased to announce that Jade Jiang is the recipient of an Associate in Music, Australia Diploma (AMusA) a high standard achievement for her Performance in Piano awarded by the Australian Music Examination Board (AMEB) in a graduation ceremony held in Sydney.

At 19, few students reach this level. "It is a difficult exam to pass. It requires dedication, hard work, hours of practice, talent, and a love for music", said Jade's piano teacher, Svetlana Vokurka.

In 2017 Jade Jiang was awarded the Irvine Family Piano Scholarship. At that time Jade commented, "for me playing the piano enables me to express myself, even when words fail. I am able to use music as a platform that allows me to communicate with any audience, as music is a universal language that binds us even in diversity".
